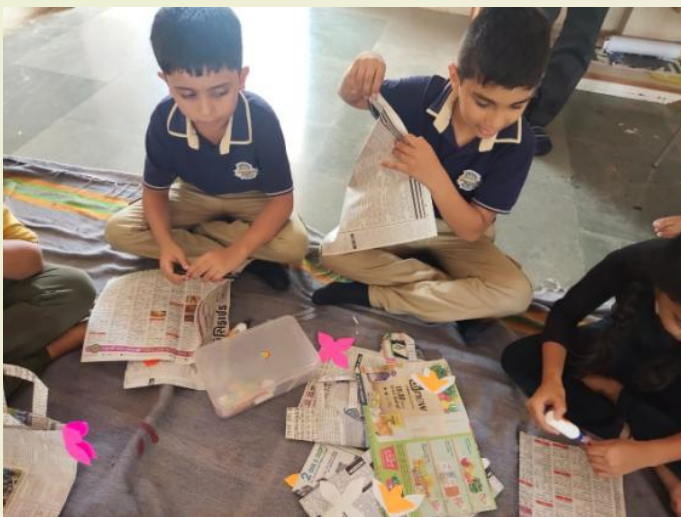
## Green Day & Yellow Day

### Paper Bag Day Activity






### PTM

Principals of all schools were introduced to the learnings from Dr. Lakshmi Khilari's visit to Japan aimed to study about the education system of Japan.



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

#### SECONDARY EDUCATION

- Primary education is followed by the 3 lower grades of secondary education (lower education) at junior high school.
- The curriculum consists of the following subjects: Japanese, social studies, mathematics, science, music, arts, physical education, industrial arts and homemaking, foreign language, elective subjects and **MORAL EDUCATION**. This is an important period for Japanese pupils, as their school results determine whether they will be accepted to a good upper secondary school in the 3 upper grades of secondary education

#### PRIMARY EDUCATION

- Primary education is provided by primary schools which lasts 6 years and is intended for children of ages 6 to 12 (Grade 1-6).
- Pupils can enter the system if they have reached the age of 6 as of 1 April.
- The curriculum consists of Japanese, Social studies, Mathematics, Science, English, music, arts and handicrafts, homemaking, and physical education. In addition, a great deal of attention is devoted to **MORAL EDUCATION**.

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### TEACHER TRAINING

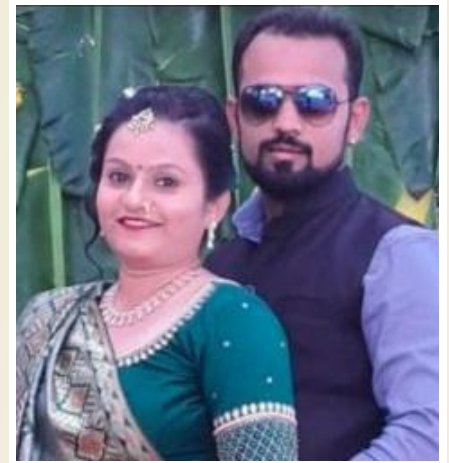
Teachers of SISU are always eager to learn and Education India provides ample opportunities for teachers to interact with experts and upgrade their skills as teachers.
